CARDS for the shut-ins, ill and isolated brethren can be found near the Distribution Table.

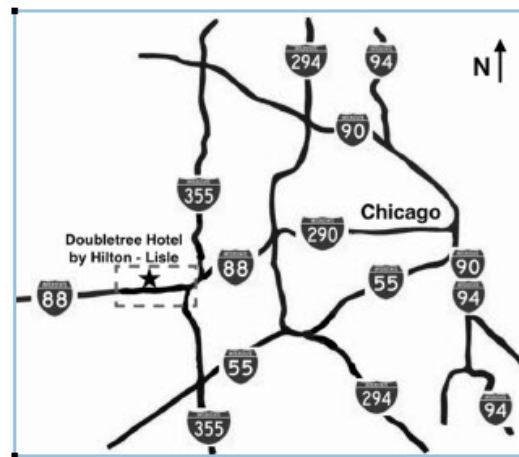

Map & Directions



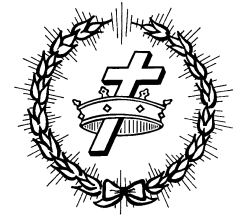
From Interstate 88 (Westbound):
