NAME BADGES are encouraged. If you cannot find your name badge, supplies will be provided for you to make your own.

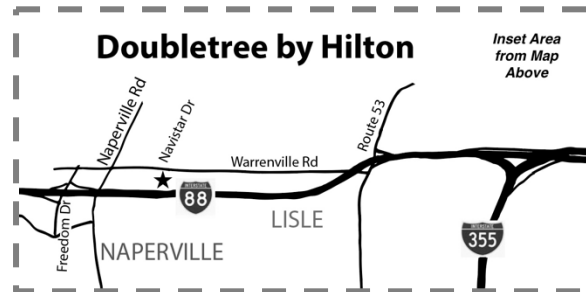
