CARDS for the shut-ins, ill, and isolated brethren can be found in the entrance hallway.

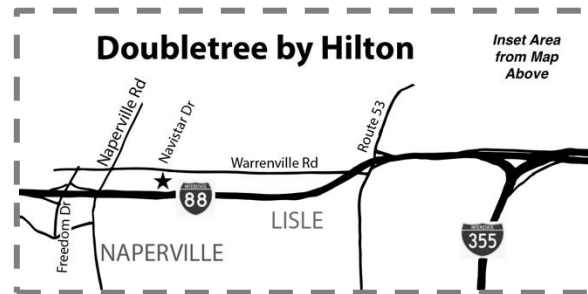
